After a competitive bid process, MCBC was awarded the contract for the Small Business Development Center (SBDC) for Monterey and San Benito Counties.

Thanks to our partnership with the County of Monterey, we have funded and overseen several impactful studies, including a Retail Market Assessment for South County and the first Industries & Economic Trends Report for Monterey County that relies on data from the EDD. #### Business Workshops
